She was the first African American Librarian in Vauxhall, New Jersey. Through the years, Mrs. Shell used her intelligence, coupled with commitment and study, to acquire the professional skills needed to perform various duties. This resulted in a steady stream of promotions beginning with the moved from Junior Library Assistant to Senior Library Assistant in 1957.

Later, Mrs. Shell worked in the Reference Department and in the 1960s was promoted to scheduling all employees within the Township's library system.
